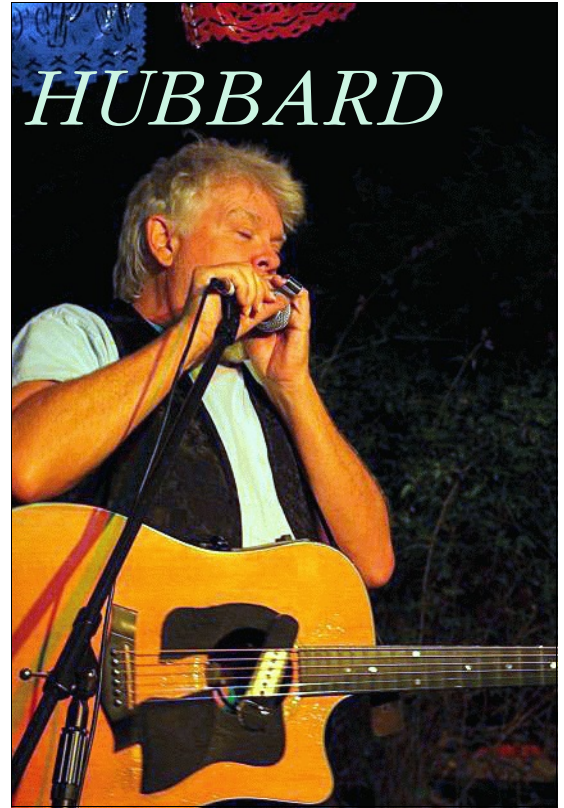

Dana Hubbard's been described as “a cross between Bruce Cockburn and Jorma Kaukonen.” He combines the socially conscious singer/songwriter with the master acoustic blues guitarist, awing people with guitar skills that defy the ear and eye — skills that are amazing to watch and a joy to listen to. You hear the bass and the back beat rhythm along with the melody and chords. If you look around for his backup guitar, you won't find one. This is Dana, performing solo, using only his hands. On his third CD "The Grounds Keepers" each track is a single guitar performance with no overdubs, no re-makes.
